What's New at Diamond Peak for the 2015-16 Season

New season pass perks, improved glade skiing and more

INCLINE VILLAGE, Nev. (September, 2015) – New for the 2015-16 season, Diamond Peak will add new perks for season passholders, improved gladed terrain, more taps in the Loft Bar, and more ways to save. Here are some reasons to visit Diamond Peak this winter:

New Season Pass Perks: Diamond Peak 2015-16 season passholders will enjoy new perks this season. Improved Glade Skiing and Riding: Diamond Peak continues to improve the health and safety of the forest and ski trails with the defensible space program. Forest thinning during the summer helps reduce fire danger by increasing defensible space, but has the added benefit of making tree skiing even better. Look for new off-piste skiable terrain in the trees between Diamondback and Spillway, located off of Crystal Ridge.

New Ski & Snowboard Equipment: The Diamond Peak Rental & Repair shop will carry the latest skis and snowboards available for demo rentals this season. Try top-of-the-line equipment from Salomon, Rossignol, K2, Volkl & Lib Tech as well as the latest Burton snowboards. The Rossignol Soul7 is a great all mountain ski and the new Salomons are great for carving. Ladies will love the new Volkl line, made for women.

New Electric Vehicle Charging Stations: Two electric vehicle (EV) charging stations were installed at Diamond Peak in the spring of 2014 allowing drivers to charge their EVs while on the go and fully charge their EV in a matter of hours. The four Eaton 70-amp 240V J1772 Level 2 chargers are networked via ChargePoint. ChargePoint requires a membership but are free for the public to use for the first five years.

Ski More, Save More with the Flex Pass: The more you ski, the more you save with a Flex Pass multiday ticket. Available in 2-7 day increments, this direct-to-lift pass is fully transferable, can be used any day and is valid all season.

Wednesday 55+ Ski Clinic Series: Diamond Peak will offer a special ski clinic series for Adults 55+ as part of the Incline Village Recreation Center Senior Programs. This 10-week program will now be available as a full series, daily lesson, or 5-pack. The 5-pack allows skiers to choose any five lessons to attend in the series. Diamond Peak's PSIA certified instructors will provide beginner, intermediate, and advanced instruction. Instruction is designed to help skiers improve, adjust, or modify techniques and encourage lifelong skiing. Re-entry skiers are welcome! Three & Free Guarantee: Diamond Peak will offer a new lesson program for beginners called the Three & Free Guarantee. Beginners pay only \$119 for a Diamond Club Membership, which includes: three beginner packages complete with rental equipment, group lessons and beginner lift tickets. Once Diamond Club Members complete the three lessons they earn a free all-mountain lift ticket and 1-day equipment rental. The Three & Free program is offered Tuesday-Thursday, non-holiday, for ages 4 and up. Ages 7+ can register at the Diamond Peak ticket windows for a ski or snowboard Diamond Club membership; ages 4-7 can register at the Child Ski Center (ski only).

Diamond Peak Ski Resort History

From Ski Incline to Diamond Peak

Diamond Peak Ski Resort began in 1966 as Ski Incline, the brain child of Oklahoma native Art Wood. Wood had a master plan for a year-round, resort community at Lake Tahoe. Incline Village was to become the “Pebble Beach” of the Sierra. In 1966, Wood hired Austrian ski consultant, Luggi Foeger, to design and build Ski Incline. In November, after only four months of construction, Ski Incline opened, boasting the only snowmaking equipment in Tahoe.

In 1987, Ski Resort Manager Jurgen Wetzstein led the development of the upper mountain and the addition of a mile-long chairlift to reach the top of the peak. This expansion doubled Ski Incline’s skiable acreage and added more advanced terrain. With the increased acreage, the resort extended the snowmaking system to cover the upper mountain along with adding more grooming equipment. Since most of the new trails were black diamonds, Ski Incline was re-named Diamond Peak. 1987 was also when the Child Ski Center was developed and the resort added a free shuttle service throughout the community.

With the turn of the century, Diamond Peak embarked on a two-part, \$8.5-million-dollar capital improvement project. In 2002, it again expanded and improved the snowmaking system to permit snowmaking capabilities on 75 percent of developed terrain. The mid-mountain Snowflake Lodge was also renovated and expanded with a new wrap-around deck featuring panoramic views of Lake Tahoe and the Sierra Nevada mountain range.

In 2003, Diamond Peak replaced its old Crystal Quad with a new high-speed detachable quad to the top of the mountain. The \$2.8-million-dollar investment replaced the 16-year-old chair with new technology and cut the ride time in half, getting skiers and boarders to the 8540’ summit in just five minutes.

In 2008, Diamond Peak spent \$4 million dollars renovating the base lodge which included an expanded rental shop, Loft Bar, and 300-square-foot outdoor patio, in addition to the existing wrap-around sun deck, a 300-square-foot meeting room, new restrooms, fixtures, siding and more.

In the summer of 2009, Diamond Peak rebuilt its snowmaking system to allow for more efficient snow production. In 2010, Diamond Peak completed a large renovation project with a new Skier Services Building, featuring a plaza area, ticket windows, Child Ski Center, Ski Patrol, and offices.

In 2013 the resort began the process of updating its Master Plan to revisit the potential for future development and introduce summer activities. In 2014, Diamond Peak added electric vehicle charging stations, two new snowcats, and upgraded its grooming fleet with SNOWsat and SNOWsatZ grooming and snowmaking technology.

Diamond Peak continues to make improvements to snowmaking and is currently assessing the system for upgrades to maximize snowmaking capacity. The Master Plan process is moving along and will be presented to the Board of Trustees for approval in the fall of 2015. Visit diamondpeakmasterplan.com for more information about future plans.
