Incline Village Tennis Center to open May 9

New programs, clinics and special events on tap for 2016 tennis and pickleball season.

INCLINE VILLAGE, Nev. (May 6, 2016) – The Incline Village Tennis Center opens for play on Monday, May 9 (weather permitting). Located next to the Recreation Center, the Incline Village Tennis Center offers 11 recently-resurfaced tennis courts as well as eight lined pickleball courts in a picturesque alpine setting next to the flowing Third Creek. The Tennis Center is open to the public and is available on a first-come, first-served basis.

The Tennis Center Pro Shop offers a full line of Babolat and Volkl rackets, pickleball paddles, Nike and Tail apparel and shoes, professional racket stringing, and demo rackets and paddles available for use by guests without their own rackets with them or looking to try something new.

Taught by USPTA certified instructors, adult private, semi-private and group lessons are available all season long. The Tennis Center also offers beginners clinics, adult boot camps, and doubles warm-up drills clinics, all under the oversight of Director of Tennis Serena Quarelli.

Recurring and special events include daily adult cardio & skills clinics, Monday Night mixed doubles play, Tuesday Ladies' Day Round-Robin play, Thursday Men's Day Round-Robin play, and tournaments.

The Incline Village Tennis Center specializes in kids programming too, with \$3 afternoon court fees for kids 12 & under (FREE for IVGID Picture Pass Holders), youth and junior classes for ages 3+, USTA Quick Start Youth Tennis Camps, and a competitive Junior Tennis Academy.

Full season membership passes are offered starting at \$449 for adults (ages 25-59), \$380 for seniors (ages 60-79), \$285 for students (ages 18-24), \$187 for juniors (ages 13-17) and \$850 for a family of up to five players – with discounted season memberships available to IVGID Picture Pass Holders. Afternoon-only membership passes are also available. Visit InclineTennis.com for full details.

Pickleball at the Incline Village Tennis Center

Recognizing the growing popularity of this new and exciting sport, the Tennis Center will offer eight lined pickleball courts during the 2016 season. Pickleball combines elements of badminton, tennis and table tennis and is played on a modified tennis court with the net lowered to 34 inches at the center. It is played with a perforated plastic ball (similar to a whiffle ball) and wood or composite paddles.

Pickleball is easy for beginners to learn, requires less movement on the court, and can develop into a quick, fast-paced, competitive game for experienced players. Please inquire about reservations, scheduled drop-in times, and socials in the Tennis Center Pro Shop. A minimum of 4 people is required to reserve a pickleball court and up to 16 people may play on one court.
