My priorities over the next year will include managing IVGID through the COVID-19 pandemic, conducting a utility reserve fund and rate study, managing the effluent pipeline and pond lining project, revising Ordinance 7, and improving our capital planning and internal controls, to name a few."*

Winquest's role as general manager became effective on July 1, 2020.
