We offer rental of four group picnic areas at the beaches, two at Incline Beach and two at Burnt Cedar Beach, which has an outdoor pool. At Incline Beach, the group picnic areas include the east end along the creek and the center BBQ in front of the snack bar. At Burnt Cedar Beach, group picnic area's include the east end and the center BBQ pit.

Keep in mind, we offer no exclusivity of any area on our beaches. The grassy area along the west end of the sandy beach at Burnt Cedar, known as the "jetty," is not part of any rental.

Each group picnic area includes seating for approximately 100 people and a BBQ unit. The center BBQ pit at Burnt Cedar is the largest pit. To reserve one of these areas and use the beaches, you must have a valid beach access IVGID Pass. If you do not have a valid beach access IVGID Pass, someone who does must be in contact with us, complete the application for you, and be present for the duration of your event.

Any guests attending the event, who do not hold a valid beach access IVGID Pass or Recreation Punch Card, must be accounted for with beach hosts at the gate. Current beach access fees will apply to all adults (18 & older) and youths (6-17) who do not have a valid beach access IVGID Pass. Children 5 & under are free. Please call the Parks & Recreation Department at 775-832-1310 to get current beach access rates.

There are several ways to arrange payment of guests who do not hold a valid beach access IVGID Pass or Recreation Punch Card. The options are as follows:

1. Leave a credit card with beach hosts. Hosts will tally the number of guests and charge your credit card for the amount owed.
2. Leave a valid beach access Recreation Punch Card(s) with beach hosts. Hosts will tally the number of guests and deduct from the Recreation Punch Card(s) the amount owed.
3. Purchase daily beach passes. A valid beach access IVGID Pass holder can purchase daily beach passes (one per guest) at the Parks & Recreation Department prior to the event.
4. Guests pay the daily beach access fee. Guests can pay for their access to the beach once they identify themselves with your event to the gate hosts.

If you're thinking about a wedding, we are limited in what we offer. Weddings that take place on our beaches are generally very casual since we do not allow formal setup of tables, chairs, archways, or floral arrangements, amplified sound nor the use of outside catering services. Please refer to Beach Rules & Regulations (pg 7,8) for more information.

We offer one group picnic area at Preston Park. This site is perfect for a family gathering or your child's birthday party and can be reserved by both valid IVGID Pass holders and non-residents.

If you decide to rent any of our group picnic areas, complete an application and return it with payment to the Parks & Recreation Department. Payment is due with application. We reserve on a first-come, first-serve basis. Beginning January 1, we will accept applications for events held within that same calendar year. A valid credit card number is required with application. No same day reservations are accepted.

Refund Policy: You will receive a full refund if you cancel more than 30 days in advance of the date of your event, and a 50% refund if cancelled within 30 days of event. There are no refunds due to inclement weather.

Love the sun and beach? This is the group picnic area for you! Located on the beach at the east end of the park near the creek and playground, this large site is perfect for your family gathering. Spread a beach towel nearby and get ready to soak up the sun and have fun while watching the kids at the playground or in the lake. This site can be reserved by valid IVGID Pass holders only.



Center BBQ

Conveniently located between the Incline Beach snack bar and the swimming beach, this site is the perfect place to celebrate on a hot summer day. This group picnic area offers a wonderful mix of shade and sun and includes a large BBQ unit and ample seating for your large group. This site can be reserved by valid IVGID Pass holders only.

Center BBQ Pit

Beach Rules & Regulations

1. Access to the beaches shall be by valid beach access IVGID Pass, beach access Recreation Punch Card or daily Beach Pass for each individual, unless otherwise specified and/or approved by the District. Trespassing is prohibited at all times.
2. Vehicle parking is allowed in designated areas only. All vehicles in violation of parking restrictions shall be subject to towing at the owners expense.
3. Glass containers of any kind are prohibited within the beach properties at all times.
4. Pets are prohibited on Incline Beach or Burnt Cedar Beach properties at all times. Dogs are allowed only on Ski Beach between mid-October and mid-April.
5. Loud playing of radios or other electronic equipment is prohibited. Amplified sound devices may not be used unless prior written permission is given by the District.
6. All beach gates will close at 10:00 P.M. daily.
7. Riding of mopeds, bicycles, and similar equipment is prohibited on all unpaved park pathways and turf areas.
8. Riding of skateboards is prohibited on the beach properties. Rollerblades are permitted to get users from the parking lots to the outside of the parks and vice versa. Other than stated, rollerblading within the parks is prohibited.
9. Nude sunbathing is prohibited on all District owned beaches at all times.
10. Fireworks of any nature are prohibited on the District owned beach properties unless authorized by the District in advance.
11. Swimming is allowed in designated swim areas only.
12. All watercraft other than non-motorized inflatable rafts or inflatable kayaks are prohibited in designated swim areas. Hard shell watercraft are not allowed in the swim areas. Motorized water craft must maintain a minimum distance of 200 feet from designated swim areas.
13. Any cooking of foods shall be in the permanent District supplied BBQ units and/or authorized privately owned gas BBQ appliances. Use of privately owned charcoal BBQ units are prohibited unless prior written permission is given by the District.
14. The vehicle speed limit in all District owned parks shall be 5 m.p.h at all times.
15. Storing of gasoline within the District owned parks shall be prohibited at any time unless authorized by the District.
16. Any diving or jumping off rocks or the boat ramp is prohibited at all times.



17. All loud, abusive and /or obscene behavior shall be prohibited at all times.
18. All open fires shall be strictly prohibited.
19. Children, 10 years of age and under, must be supervised by parents or guardians at all times.
20. Any use of the boat launching ramp or beaches for commercial purposes, unless authorized by the District, is prohibited.
21. Group use of the District-owned beaches is by facility use permit only. Groups of 20 people or more must submit an application to the Parks & Recreation Department at least seven (7) days prior to the event. Group use is limited to valid beach access IVGID Pass holders and their guests only.
22. Reservations may be made for designated group picnic areas. They may be reserved by a submitting a rental agreement and paying the rental fee.
23. The kayak / storage racks located on Ski Beach and Hermit Beach are for reserved long term rentals only. Any boats incorrectly stored on beach property will be taken to an off site storage area and fees will be charged.
24. Weddings on the District-owned properties are by permit only. An application for this use of the properties is mandatory and must be submitted to the District's Parks & Recreation Department at least seven (7) days prior to the event. Weddings are limited to eligible beach access Residents and their guests only. No set-up is allowed.
25. All federal, state and county laws or regulations shall be strictly enforced.
26. It is the District's policy to prohibit illegal drinking and/or the possession or use of illegal drugs.
27. The District, or its representatives, shall have the right to refuse access to any individual or group. The District also reserves the right to remove individuals from the beaches should these rules or regulations be violated in any way. The District and its agents shall also have the authority to revoke recreation privileges in accordance with rules established by the District in Ordinance No. 7 (Recreation Pass Policy).
28. Zero Tolerance Policy adopted April 2004 - Abusive behavior of staff or other customers will not be tolerated. All District rules must be adhered to. Recreation privileges MAY be suspended for any period deemed appropriate or privileges may be revoked at District's sole discretion

Beach Rules & Regulations



Watercraft Launching Rules & Regulations

1. Access to the boat ramp shall be by valid beach access Recreation Photo ID, beach access Recreation Punch Card or daily beach pass for each individual, unless otherwise specified and/or approved by the District. All boat riders must gain access.
2. Boat registration must be on the vehicle at all times and must be presented to District staff or its contractor for verification if requested when using District-owned facilities.
3. The vehicular traffic areas within Ski Beach (watercraft launching facility) are designated loading zones for watercraft launching and retrieval only. Any parking of vehicles and/or trailers in these areas is strictly prohibited at all times.
4. The District may close the boat ramp to launching at its discretion without notice.
5. A 5 mph speed limit exists inside of the larger white buoys and within 200 feet of designated swim areas.
6. All powered watercraft must stay 100 feet from any person in the water.
7. Overnight mooring is prohibited.
8. All beach gates will be closed at 10:00 P.M. daily.
9. Pets are not allowed on beach properties except at Ski Beach between mid-October and mid-April.
10. Swimming or wading is not allowed within the boat or personal watercraft use area.
12. All watercraft muffler systems must be in compliance with state and federal noise level standards.
13. All watercraft must be operated in a safe and courteous manner at all times.
14. Storing of flammables is prohibited on the District-owned beach properties. No refueling shall take place on the property.
15. The vehicle speed limit is 5 mph within the parks.
16. Any use of the boat launching ramp or beaches for commercial purposes, unless authorized by the District, is prohibited.
17. It is not advisable to use the boat-launching ramp when high wind conditions exist on the lake. Use under any conditions is at the risk of the participant.
18. The District reserves the right to remove individuals from the beaches and boat launching facility should these rules or regulations be violated in any way. The District and its agents shall also have the authority to revoke recreation privileges in accordance with rules established by the District in Ordinance No. 7 (Recreation Pass Policy).
