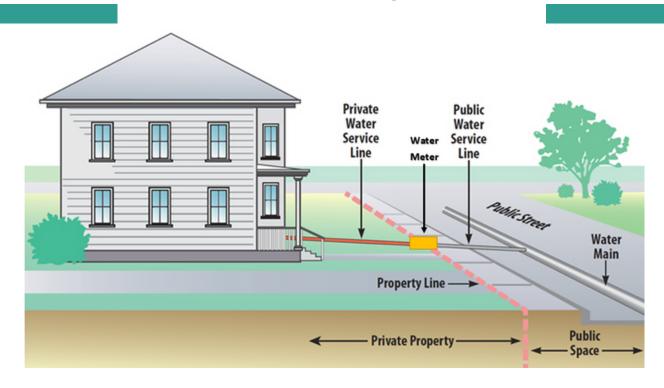

WE NEED YOUR HELP WITH THE WATER SERVICE LINE INVENTORY!

IVGID Public Works Department needs your help to complete an inventory of all water service line pipes connected to the public water system.

Check your private water service line, then complete our online survey to tell us what you find, no matter what type of pipes you find!

Please complete our online Service Line Survey to inform us of the material used for the water service line coming into your property. It is the pipe connected to your water meter.

>>> THE IMPORTANCE OF METER STAKES IN WINTER

The blue meter stake at your property helps us quickly locate your water meter and service line.

Customers are responsible for allowing IVGID access to the water meter. In the winter, the stake still needs to be accessible. It is used to locate your water meter in a timely manner in order to turn off your water in case of a water leak or emergency.

Removal of meter stakes can result in a tamper fine. Please do not remove blue meter stakes. Do not cover the meter box with dirt, rocks, plants or hardscape. These greatly impede the ability to shut off the meter and water supply for repairs.

If your meter stake is covered in snow, we can usually find the stake with a metal detector so we know where to start digging.

If you are missing a meter stake, please contact us and we will make sure to install one in spring.
