



DOG WASTE AFFECTS WATER QUALITY

Dog poop; not just an aesthetic issue, but a water quality issue. At Lake Tahoe and many other areas throughout the United States, people have become concerned about the effects of accumulated dog waste on water quality. Dog waste, like any waste, may contain a variety of microbes, some of which could cause disease. Examples of diseases that can potentially be transmitted from dogs to humans through feces include Salmonella, Giardia, E-Coli and Cryptosporidium.

Tahoe's water providers maintain a rigorous schedule of raw and finished water testing and use state-of-the-art disinfection processes to remove or inactivate pathogenic microbes; keeping your drinking water safe.

A study conducted by scientists at the UNR Cooperative Extension found that the drying out of dog feces kills off harmful bacteria's that are typically present in feces. These findings suggest that the risk of water contamination from dog feces is greatest during the cooler, wetter months when there is increased snowmelt and rainfall, coupled with lower evaporation rates. During these times it is important to pick up dog waste and dispose of it in the trash can or toilet to reduce the contamination potential on water quality.
