Save yourself the hassle of scheduling an appointment to drop off half-empty paint cans; come get free paint drier packets from IVGID Public Works. We are now offering this product to our residential customers. Just add the powder to latex or acrylic paint and stir. It accelerates the paint drying process inside the can. Once dry, the solidified paint can be safely disposed of in the trash.

When dry, latex paint is not hazardous waste, but is costly to dispose of when wet, so this paint drier option will provide a significant cost savings while still protecting District infrastructure and the environment.

REPLACE YOUR TOILET OR WASHING MACHINE AND RECEIVE UP TO \$100

The first 100 applications for high efficiency appliances are eligible for one rebate per parcel, up to \$100 credit towards their IVGID utility bill.

High-efficiency appliances eligible for the rebate include WaterSense toilets using 1.28 gallons of water per flush, or Energy Star washing machines that have a water factor of 3.7 or less.
