

IVGID'S CERTIFIED WATER AND WASTEWATER LABORATORY



Did you know that tap water is more rigorously tested than bottled water? Our Chief Chemist, Kristine Lebo, does a great job sampling our drinking water to ensure it is safe to drink every day. Checks are performed routinely to ensure we meet regulatory requirements on both our water and wastewater systems. Annually you see some of these results published in the Consumer Confidence Report (CCR).

Water and wastewater samples are analyzed in our certified lab, which is inspected biennially by the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection. The lab just passed its most recent inspection, which met requirements for the organization and equipment needed to ensure correct performance of accredited tests. Each chemist is also required to perform a quarterly lab check, and submit the results to the State, to ensure they know the processes for each test they perform.

On top of the testing performed to meet regulatory requirements, the lab analyzes samples from our water and wastewater systems to check or improve the treatment processes. We also use the lab to complete stream sampling in order to maintain historical data on the Lake Tahoe watershed.

Water and wastewater samples are analyzed for bacteria, nutrients, metals, hazardous chemicals, and temperature. These tests look for presence of contaminants in parts per billion (ppb) and parts per million (ppm). A way to visualize one part per billion in water is to think of it as one drop in a 10,000-gallon swimming pool. One part per million is about 1 cup of water in the same size swimming pool.
