The Incline Village General Improvement District (IVGID) Board of Trustees will hold a public hearing to consider proposed updates to the District's water and sewer rates and related fees following completion of the District's Water and Sewer Rate Study.

All IVGID water and sewer customers are encouraged to attend and will have the opportunity to ask questions, provide comments and share feedback before the Board considers adoption of the proposed rates.

Preliminary rate and fee information has been available for public review since April 13, 2026, at IVGID offices and online. # YARD WASTE COLLECTION - 2026 SEASON

## WASTE MANAGEMENT YARD WASTE STICKERS WILL BE ARRIVING SOON

Waste Management yard waste stickers will be arriving soon. Collection will run in two seasons: Spring, May 4–July 17, 2026, and Fall, September 28–October 30, 2026. Each residential service account will receive 96 stickers, with one sticker required for each heavy-duty yard waste bag (maximum 40 lbs). Bags will be collected on the regular service day.

## NEW FOR 2026

Black plastic or heavy-duty paper yard waste bags are allowed. Bags must be kept dry to prevent breakage and spillage during collection. Bags that are overweight or wet will not be collected until corrected. Noncompliant bags set out during the final week of collection will be picked up the following week as garbage, and additional fees may apply.

Join the community on June 13, 2026, for the Incline Green Clean community cleanup followed by the Summer Kickoff Block Party.
