

HUNTING PROGRAM INFORMATIONAL PACKET

- 1) Site location is at 3050 Vicky Lane, Minden, NV.
- 2) The phone number at the Wetlands is 775-267-3229. Phone is only answered during the designated hunting days/times. There will usually be a taped message for information during the hunting season but is not guaranteed.
- 3) Hunting is governed by the Federal and State of Nevada regulations.
- 4) Be prepared for inspection by Federal and/or State Game Wardens at any time.
- 5) Supervisors will always be on site during hunt days.
- 6) Please read and understand all hunting regulations and violation point system.
- 7) Driving on secondary roads at the Wetlands is not allowed except by hunting supervisors on duty.
- 8) Reasonable assistance will be given to those with special needs, (handicapped) to get them to the handicapped blind.
- 9) The longest walk to any hunting area is approximately 1 mile.
- 10) It is your responsibility to confirm and follow the 2026/2027 NDOW Waterfowl hunting schedules and limits.
- 11) Swan hunting is not allowed in Douglas County.
- 12) All hunters must be paid members; guests must pay the day of hunting on-site by check only.
- 13) Any new information will be posted on IVGID's Recreation website.





PLEASE READ BEFORE APPLYING

Here is a synopsis of what is tentatively scheduled and the limitations. Hunters will choose a blind based on the lowest number drawn/obtained lottery style, starting with the lowest number choosing a blind first then the next lowest number until all hunters have chosen a blind.

Vehicles are to leave access into the gated control building area and access along Vicky Lane and the dirt road open to the traveling public at all times.

Guests will be allowed this hunting season. Members may bring a total of three guests per season, of which one guest may hunt twice.

Blinds that are tentatively scheduled to be open this season:

BLINDS - HC - 1 - 2 - 4 - 5 - 6 - 7 - 8 - 9 - 10 - 12 - 13 - 14 - 15 - 16 - 17 - 18 - 19
20 - 23 - 25 - 26 - 27 - 28 - 29 - 30.

THESE BLINDS ARE NOT GUARANTEED AND MAY CHANGE AT ANY TIME.

Areas A, B & C may be hunted, but there are no blinds in these areas.

IVGID Hunt Supervisors will hold a workday on-site at 8:00 am on September 12 & 13, 2026 (7:00am – 3:00pm). Members who work 8 hours will earn one work credit, to be used in the 2026/2027 hunting season to bring a guest or as a one-time preferred draw.

NDOW hunting dates are:

Junior hunt dates: October 3, 2026, and February 13, 2027.

Waterfowl hunting season: October 17, 2026, to January 3, 2027.

NDOW Closed hunting dates January 4 and 5, 2027.

Reopening January 6, 2027, to January 31, 2027.

IVGID Recreation Center is closed Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.
